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CONSULTATION AGREEMENT AND ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF RECEIPT OF DISCLOSURES AND INSTRUCTIONS

This Agreement is entered into on this ____ day of _____, 20____, by and between _____, (hereinafter referred to as the "Client" whether one or more) and **The Law Office of Shannon L. Foster** (hereinafter the "Attorney").

Client has requested the opportunity to consult with and obtain information and advice from the Attorney obtaining relief from debts, including relief from debts by filing bankruptcy under the United States Bankruptcy Code. If the Client retains the Attorney to file a bankruptcy, the parties shall execute a separate contract setting forth the fees and other terms of such representations. - b. To the extent possible, based on the information provided by the Client, advise the Client of the Client's bankruptcy options and non-bankruptcy options.
- c. If the Client has not provided the Attorney with sufficient information upon which to fully advise the Client on the Client's options, inform the Client what information the Client needs to provide to enable the Attorney to provide such advice and information.
- d. Advise the Client of the requirements placed upon the Client to file a Chapter 7 or 13 bankruptcy.
- e. To the extent possible, quote the Client an estimated fee for the Attorney's services to provide bankruptcy assistance or other legal services to the Client.

The Client acknowledges that the first date upon which the attorney has first offered to provide any bankruptcy assistance service is this date, and that the Attorney provided the Client with the Notice to Client Who Contemplates Filing Bankruptcy, the Statement Mandated by Section 527(b) of the Bankruptcy Code, and the Instructions on Providing Information Required to File Bankruptcy, copies of which are attached to this Consultation Agreement.
